L.D. 2197, Bill, "AN ACT Redistributing the Powers of the
Executive Council."

Amendment
Amend said / in the 10th and 11th lines by striking
out the underlined words "the Chairmen of the Joint Standing
Committee on Judiciary" and in the 14th line by striking out
the underlined words "Judiciary Committee" and inserting in
place thereof the underlined word 'Legislature'

Further amend said Amendment in the 18th line by striking
out the underlined words "Judiciary Committee" and inserting
in place thereof the underlined word 'Legislature'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to correct errors in
the House Amendment.

The first part deletes a reference to the Chairmen of the
Judiciary Committe as members of the Criminal Justice Planning
and Assistance Agency. The chairman of that committee was
removed from membership in the agency by an amendment in the
regular session.

The 2nd and 3rd parts correct a reference to confirmation
by the Judiciary Committee, which would be in conflict with the

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constitutional amendment, which provides only one procedure
for legislative confirmation.
