SENATE AMENDMENT " B " to H.P. 1997, L.D. 2197, Bill, "AN ACT Redistributing the Powers of the Executive Council."

Amend said Bill in section 419 by inserting at the end the following underlined sentence:

'The Commissioner of Environmental Protection shall be a non-voting member of the board.'
