SENATE AMENDMENT "D" to H.P. 1997, L.D. 2197, Bill,
"AN ACT Redistributing the Powers of the Executive Council."

Amend said Bill by inserting after section 231 the
following:

'Sec. 231-A. 22 MRSA §5108, as enacted by PL 1973,
c. 630, §1 and as last amended by PL 1975, c. 293, §4,
is further amended to read:

§5108. Committee

There shall be, within the Department of Human Services,
the Maine Committee on Aging which shall consist of 15 members,
who shall be appointed by the Governor ~~with the advice and
consent of the Executive Council.~~

Statement of Fact

This amendment corrects an error in the bill by inserting
a provision relating to the appointment of the Maine Committee
on Aging. The amendment would give this authority to the
Governor alone.
