HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 687, L.D. 2198, Bill,  
"AN ACT to Regulate Drinking Water."

Amend said Bill by striking out in the first sentence of subsection 8 of that part designated "§2601." of section 4 the underlined figure "30" and inserting in place thereof the underlined figure '60'

Statement of Fact

This amendment changes from 30 to 60 days the time provision in the definition of "public water system." This change is consistent with the federal statutes and will ensure the exclusion of water systems supplying seasonal agricultural laborers from the definition.
