H.P. 2022, L.D. 2201, Bill, "AN ACT to Establish a Division  
of Travel Information."

Amend said Amendment by adding after the 2nd blocked  
paragraph of paragraph D of section 3 the following:


'Any contract between the State or any of its agencies  
and the State of Maine Publicity Bureau shall specify that  
the State of Maine Publicity Bureau shall not discriminate  
against any individual, partnership, corporation or other  
legal entity involved in the vacation-travel industry on the  
basis of membership in the State of Maine Publicity Bureau  
or on the basis of the payment of fees to the State of Maine  
Publicity Bureau.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment provides that any state contract with  
the State of Maine Publicity Bureau shall provide that the  
bureau shall not discriminate against any individual, partnership  
or corporation on the basis of membership in the bureau or  
payment of fees to the bureau.
