COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "f" to H.P. 2034, L.D. 2207, Bill,
"AN ACT to Amend the Protection and Improvement of Air Statutes."

Amend said Bill in section 4 in that part designated
"§603." in subsection 1 by striking out all of paragraph C
and renumbering paragraph D to be paragraph C.

Statement of Fact

This amendment will make regulation pertaining to the
percent of sulfur content in fuel for new users the same as that
pertaining to present users in the Portland Penninsula Air Quality
Region. The percent is 1.5 by weight.
