COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 2046, L.D. 2218, Bill,
AN ACT Concerning the Workmen's Compensation Statutes."

Amend said Bill in section 3 by inserting in the 2nd line of paragraph A of subsection 5 after the underlined words and punctuation "cities," the following underlined word and punctuation 'towns,' (first line in L.D.)

Further amend said Bill in section 3 by striking out all of the 2nd sentence of subparagraph (2) of paragraph A of subsection 5 and inserting in place thereof the following underlined sentence: 'Fire-fighters and policemen shall be deemed employees within the meaning of this Act.'

Further amend said Bill in section 3 by striking out in the 6th line of subparagraph (2) of paragraph A of subsection 5 (4th and 5th lines of L.D.) the underlined word "Employees" and inserting in place thereof the underlined word 'Employers'

Further amend said Bill in section 5 by inserting in the 4th line (3rd line in L.D.) after the word "preexisting" the following underlined word: 'permanent'

Further amend said Bill in section 5 by striking out in the 5th line (4th line in L.D.) the following: "and"

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of section 7.

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to clarify the language of the bill.
