COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 2052, L.D. 2219, Bill,
"AN ACT to Conform Certain Maine Statutes to the 14th Amendment
of the Constitution of the United States, to Title VII of the
United States Civil Rights Act of 1964, as Amended in 1972, and
to the Maine Human Rights Act."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of section 11.

Further amend said Bill by inserting after section 24 the following:

'Sec. 24-A. 39 MRSA §2, sub-§10 is enacted to read:

10. Dependent of another person. For purposes of the

payment or the termination of compensation pursuant to section 58,
shall be
a widow or widower of a deceased employee / the dependent of

another person when over half of his or her support during a

calendar year was provided by the other person.'

Further amend said Bill by renumbering the sections to read consecutively.

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to delete the provision in section 11 of the bill which repeals Title 22, section 4761, subsection 3, and to clarify what is meant by the term "dependent of another person" in the amendments to the workmen's compensation law.
