HOUSE AMENDMENT"**B**" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT"A" to S.P. 699, L.D.

2223,/"AN ACT to Promote Efficiency in Maine State Government."

Amend said amendment by striking out all of the first paragraph.

Further amend said amendment by inserting at the end of the  
4th paragraph the following:

'Further amend said Bill by inserting before section 8 the  
following:

Sec. 8. 34 MRSA §2062 as repealed and replaced by PL 1975,  
c. 747, §2, is repealed.

Sec. 9. Effective date. Section 8 of this Act shall become  
effective 91 days after adjournment of the Legislature.'

Further amend said amendment by inserting before the last  
paragraph before the statement of fact the following:

'Further amend said Bill by inserting before the emergency  
clause the following:

Sec. 9. Authorization to dispose of Vickery-Hill Building  
and surrounding land. The Director of the Bureau of Public  
Improvements, at his discretion, is authorized, with the consent  
of the Governor and Council, to dispose of the Vickery-Hill Building  
and surrounding land.'

This amendment would leave the funds generated from the sale  
of food in the food account of the department.
