SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 699, L.D. 2223, Bill, "AN ACT to Promote Efficiency in Maine State Government."

Amend said Amendment by striking out all of the first 2 paragraphs.

Further amend said Amendment by striking out in the first line of the 3rd paragraph the words "Further amend" and inserting in place thereof the word 'Amend'

Further amend said Amendment by inserting at the end of the 4th paragraph the following:

'Sec. 7. 34 MRSA §2062, as repealed and replaced by P.L. 1975, 747, §2, is repealed.

Sec. 8. Effective date. Section 7 of this Act shall become effective 91 days after adjournment of the Legislature.'

Further amend said Amendment by striking out all of the last paragraph before the Statement of Fact and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Further amend said Bill by inserting before the emergency clause the following:

Sec. 9. Authorization to dispose of Vickery-Hill Building and surrounding land. The Director of the Bureau of Public Improvements, at his discretion, is authorized, with the consent of the Governor and Council, to dispose of the Vickery-Hill Building and surrounding land.'

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Further amend said Amendment by inserting before the Statement of Fact the following:

'Further amend said Bill by renumbering the sections to read consecutively.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment reinstates in the Bill a provision under which income derived from the sale of meals by the Department of Mental Health and Corrections accrues to the General Fund, as it has in the past, and a provision concerning publications and documents.

This amendment also authorizes the disposal of the Vickery-Hill Building and resolves a conflict between various provisions applicable to the Director of Mental Retardation enacted by c.747 and c.755, by adopting the language of chapter 755.
