SENATE AMENDMENT "H" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 699,
L.D. 2223, Bill, "AN ACT to Promote Efficiency in Maine State
Government."

Amend said Amendment by inserting before the last paragraph
before the Statement of Fact the following:

'Further amend said Bill by inserting at the end before the
Emergency clause the following:

Sec. 9. Classification Appeals Fund. There is established
a Classification Appeals Fund to provide all departments regardless
of source of funds with an emergency reserve to assure that
adequate funding is available for additional costs of classification
← appeals. The State Budget Officer shall evaluate the financial
impact of the decisions of the Temporary Compensation Review Board
as soon as their work is complete but not later than December 31,
1976 and authorize such transfers to the various departments as
may be necessary if insufficient funds are not available from
regular departmental sources. Any unused balance of the fund shall
lapse to the General Fund January 31, 1977.

Sec. 10. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General
Fund the sum of \$500,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1977
to the Department of Finance and Administration, Bureau of the
Budget, for the establishment of the Classification Appeals Fund.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment provides additional funds to fund successful departmental appeals should funds not be available from existing/funds.
