SENATE AMENDMENT " I " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 699,
L.D. 2223, Bill, "AN ACT to Promote Efficiency in Maine State
Government."

Amend said Amendment by inserting after the 2nd paragraph the follow
Further

Amend said Bill by inserting after section 4 the following:

'Sec. 4-A. 5 MRSA §711, sub-§11, as last repealed and replaced
by PL 1975, c. 755, §1, is repealed and the following enacted in
place thereof:

11. Officials of the Department of Mental Health and Corrections.
The associate commissioners, the directors of Mental Health, of
Mental Retardation and of Corrections, the Warden of the State
Prison and the superintendents of the Augusta Mental Health
Institute, of the Bangor Mental Health Institute and of the Pineland
Center.'

Further amend said Amendment by inserting after the 4th
paragraph the following:

'Further amend said Bill by inserting after section 7 the
following:

Sec. 7-A. 34 MRSA §1, 4th ¶, as enacted by PL 1975, c. 755,
§6, is amended by inserting before the first sentence the following
new sentences:

The commissioner, subject to the approval of the Governor, shall
appoint and set the salaries for the associate commissioners and
for the Warden of the Maine State Prison. The appointments shall
be for indeterminate terms and until successors are appointed and
qualified or during the pleasure of the commissioner.'

This amendment clarifies those officials of the Department of Mental Health and Corrections who are unclassified. This amendment also clarifies the power of appointment and setting of salaries for the associate commissioners of Mental Health and Corrections and the Warden of the Maine State Prison.
