SENATE AMENDMENT "A " TO S.P. 699, L.D. 2223, Bill, "AN ACT  
to Promote Efficiency in Maine State Government."

Amend said Bill by inserting after section 4 the following:

'Sec. 4-A. 5 MRSA §7002, sub-§2, ¶A, as enacted by PL 1975,

c. 481, §3, is amended to read:


A. Appoint and remove the staff of the office and prescribe  
their duties as may be necessary to implement the purposes  
of this chapter. Professional employees authorized by this  
chapter shall be-hired-as-unclassified-employees serve at  
the pleasure of the director. All other employees shall  
be subject to the state civil service system;'

Further amend said Bill by inserting after section 8 the  
following:

'Sec. 9. PL 1975, c. 481, §6 is repealed.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to have employees authorized  
by Title 5, chapter 361 to serve at the pleasure of the director  
instead of being hired as unclassified employees and to repeal  
the transitional provisions of chapter 481 of the public laws of 1975.
