HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P.

2053, L.D. 2230, RESOLVE, for Laying of Additional County Taxes
for the Year Nineteen Hundred and Seventy-six and to Authorize
Certain Reallocations to Conform with Line Budget Statutes.

Amend said Amendment by inserting after the first paragraph the following:

'Further amend said Resolve by inserting after the title the following:

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts and resolves of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, county budgets must be apportioned during the month of April; and

Whereas, this resolve changes the amounts authorized for county budgets in 1976; and

Whereas, such authorizaton must be made prior to 1976 apportionment; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore, be it'

HOUSE AMENDMENT to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 205 , L.D. 2230,

Further amend said Amendment by inserting at the end, before the Statement of Fact, the following:

'Further amend said Resolve by inserting at the end, before the Statement of Fact, the following:

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this resolve shall take effect when approved.'

The purpose of the amendment is to add an emergency preamble to the resolve.
