Amend said Amendment in section 3 in that part designated "§2066." in subsection 2 by inserting at the end the following underlined sentence: 'However, a person who is being treated by prayer or spiritual means alone in accordance with the tenets and practices of a recognized church or religious denomination by a duly accredited practitioner thereof, may not be ordered evaluated, unless a court has determined that he is, as a result of mental disorder, a danger to himself or others.'
