SENATE AMENDMENT "C" to SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 2090,
L.D. 2249, Bill, "AN ACT to Improve Solid Waste Management."

Amend said Amendment by inserting after the 17th paragraph
the following:

'Further amend said Bill in section 16 in that part designated
"§1862." by striking out all of subsection 1 and inserting
in place thereof the following:

1. Beverage. "Beverage" means beer, ale or other drink
produced by fermenting malt or table wine as defined by Title
28, section 2, subsection 25-A, soda water or other nonalcoholic
carbonated drink in liquid form and intended for human consumption.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment changes the Senate amendment to provide
coverage for table wine under the bill, but not for liquor.
