HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 2092, L.D. 2251, Bill, "AN ACT
To Enable Counties to Hire County Administrators."

Amend said Bill in section 3 by inserting at the end of
that part designated "§202." a new paragraph to read:

'Notwithstanding section 2 and any other provision of law,
if the county commissioners hire a full-time county administra-
tor, they shall forgo the annual salary otherwise due them and
shall only receive \$25 each for each meeting attended and re-
imbursement for travel at the same rate established for state
employees.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment provides that county commissioners who hire a
full-time county administrator shall forgo their annual salary and
only receive mileage and \$25 for each meeting attended.
