HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 720, L.D. 2256, Bill, "AN ACT to Require an Annual Governor's Report on Employment and the Economy."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the title and inserting in place thereof 'AN ACT to Require the Employment Security Commission to Report on Employment and the Economy.'

Further amend said Bill in that part designated "§8." by striking out the first sentence and inserting in place thereof the following:

'The Employment Security Commission of the Department of Manpower Affairs shall, beginning January 31, 1977, and every 3 months thereafter, report to the Governor, Legislature and people of the State on employment and on the economy of this State.'

## Statement of Fact

This amendment provides that the report required of the Governor by the original bill shall be made instead, on a quarterly basis, by the Employment Security Commission.
