COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 2117, L.D. 2266, Bill, "AN ACT to Charge Supplemental Weekly Benefits for Dependents to the General Fund Account of the State Unemployment Trust Fund."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the emergency clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'26 MRSA §1221, sub-§3, ¶A-l is enacted to read:

A-1. No charge shall be made to an individual employer for supplemental weekly benefits for dependents paid in accordance with section 1191, subsection 6; charges for such benefits shall be made to the General Fund.'
