COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 2103, L.D. 2269, Bill, "AN ACT
Relating to the Trustees of the Dexter Utility District."

Amend said Bill by inserting before the enacting clause the
following:

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not
become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted
as emergencies; and

Whereas, the Town of Dexter has changed its form of municipal
government from a town meeting form to a town council form; and

Whereas, the present charter of the Dexter Utility District
is predicated on the former municipal form of government of Dexter;
and

Whereas, it is therefore necessary to alter the charter of the
utility to conform to the new form of municipal government at the
earliest possible moment; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create
an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and
require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the
preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore, '

Further amend said Bill by inserting, before the Statement of Fact, the following:

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall become effective when approved.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to add an emergency preamble and clause to the Bill.
