HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 2131,
L.D. 2277, Bill, "AN ACT Concerning Shellfish Licensing."

Amend said amendment by striking out all of the 24th, 25th
and 26th paragraphs and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Further amend said Bill in section 5 by striking out all
of paragraph A of subsection 2 of that part designated "§3757."
and inserting in place thereof the following:

A. The commissioner shall hold a public hearing prior to
adopting regulations. Notice of the public hearing shall
be published once, within 14 to 30 days before the hearing,
in 2 newspapers published daily with general, state-wide
circulation and in other newspapers or journals of general
circulation adequate to provide reasonable notice to the
public and members of the fisheries' industry affected there-
by. The regulations adopted after the hearing shall be
published in 2 newspapers published daily with general, state-
wide circulation and in other newspapers or journals of
general circulation adequate to provide reasonable notice
to the public and members of the / fisheries' industry at least
once, at least 14 days before they become effective. They
may be amended or repealed at any time by the commissioner
after like notice, hearing and publication of the portions
amended or repealed. The commissioner shall, by February
1st of each session of the Legislature, submit the regulations
to the Legislature for review.'
