HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 2131,  
L.D. 2277, Bill, "AN ACT Concerning Shellfish Licensing."

Amend said Amendment in the 11th paragraph from the end  
by striking out all of paragraphs B and C.

Further amend said Amendment in the 11th paragraph from  
the end by relettering paragraph D to be paragraph B.

Further amend said Amendment by inserting after the 11th  
paragraph from the end  
paragraph/the following:

'Further amend said Bill in section 17 in that part  
designated "§4314" by inserting in the next to the last line  
of subsection 6 after the underlined word "sale" the underlined  
words 'of his catch' (same in L.D.)

Further amend said Bill in section 17 in that part designated  
"§4314." by inserting in the last line of subsection 6 after the  
underlined word "license" the following words: 'or a holder of a  
lobster and crab fishing license or the holder of a scallop  
fishing license'

Further amend said Amendment by inserting after the 10th paragraph  
from the end the following:

'Further amend said Bill in section 17 in that part  
designated "§4315." by striking out all of paragraphs B and C  
of subsection 2 and inserting in place thereof the following:

B. The transportation or selling of his catch of  
shellfish by the holder of a commercial shellfish  
license;

C. The transportation or selling of his catch of lobsters

and crabs by the holder of a lobster and crab  
fishing license;'

Further amend said Amendment by striking out the 7th and 8th paragraphs from the end and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Further amend said Bill in section 17 by inserting at the end of subsection 2 of that part designated "\$4315." 2 new paragraphs to read:

F. To fish, shellfish, lobsters and crabs or other  
marine species not used for human consumption;

G. To the transportation or selling of his catch  
by a holder of a scallop fishing license or  
commercial fishing license.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment clarifies which activities of license holders are excepted from the definition of sale in the wholesale trade and retail seafood license.
