HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "B" to
S.P. 732, L.D. 2281, Bill, "AN ACT to Reorganize the Bureau of
Corrections."

Amend said Amendment in section 28 by striking out all
of the 2nd sentence and inserting in place thereof the
following: 'Notwithstanding any other provision of law, if,
prior to December 31, 1976, the Skowhegan location has not
been approved for use as a location of the Maine Correctional
Center, the remainder of any moneys appropriated to the
Skowhegan location in this Act shall be transferred to other
correctional institutional accounts. Notwithstanding any
other provision of law, no more than \$200,000 of the moneys
appropriated to the Skowhegan location in this Act may be
transferred to the Correctional Program Improvement Fund, as
described in Title 34, chapter 62-A.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to assure that funds
appropriated to the Skowhegan location will be available for
correctional institutions if the Skowhegan location is not opened
by December 31, 1976. The amendment also provides that no more than
\$200,000 of these funds can be transferred to the Correctional
Program Improvement Fund for community corrections programs.
