HOUSE AMENDMENT "C" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "B" to S.P. 732,
L.D. 2281, Bill, "AN ACT to Reorganize the Bureau of Corrections."

Amend said Amendment in section 20 in that part designated
"§811." by striking out in the 4th paragraph all of the 2nd
sentence and inserting in place thereof the following:

'The superintendent of the center may appoint 2 assistant
superintendents for the South Windham location and one
assistant superintendent for the Skowhegan location. These ___
appointments shall be made subject to the Personnel Law.'
