HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 2142,
L.D. 2282, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Persons Residing in Community
Residential Facilities."

Amend said Amendment in section 6 by striking out in
that part designated "§7905." all of the last blocked paragraph
of subsection 1 and inserting in place thereof the following:
'Whenever the department gives written permission to an operator
or agent to manage, hold or deposit the personal funds of any
mentally retarded residents, the department may request the Bureau
of Mental Retardation, Department of Mental Health and Corrections,
to develop, insofar as resources are available, an appropriate
plan for the management of these funds.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment clarifies the bill as to which department
is responsible for developing the plans for management of the
personal funds of a mentally retarded boarding home resident.
