SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 2144, L.D. 2284, Bill, "AN ACT to Set the Unemployment Insurance Contribution Rate for New Employers at the Average Contribution Rate for All Employers in the Previous Year."

Amend said Bill by striking out in the 6th line from the end of paragraph A (same in L.D.) the underlined figure "3.0%" and inserting in place thereof the following: '5.0%'
