COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 2]45, L.D. 2285, Bill,
"AN ACT Relating to the Effective Date of Each Individual Establishing a Benefit Year under the Unemployment Law."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'26 MRSA §1192, sub-§5, first sentence as repealed and replaced by P.L. 1975, c.568, §3, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

He has been paid during his base period wages of at least \$600 for insured work.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.'

Statement of Fact

P.L. 1975, c.568, §3 adversely affects 6,000 insured workers in Maine by causing them to loose more than \$3,000,000 in unemployment compensation benefits. This amendment mitigates this adverse effect.
