HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 738, L.D. 2288, Bill,
"AN ACT Relating to Residency for the Purposes of Municipal
Relief of the Poor."


Amend said Bill in the amending clause by inserting at
the beginning the following: 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend said Bill by adding a new section to
read:

'Sec. 2. 22 MRSA §4499, as last amended by P.L. 1975,
c. 293, §4, is further amended by adding at the end a new
paragraph to read:

When a municipality of less than 5,000 population incurs
net costs for providing general assistance to persons residing
in a nursing or convelescent home located in that municipality,
the Department of Human Services shall reimburse the municipality
in an amount equal to the net costs above \$500 for each person
in any fiscal year.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to relieve potential hard-
ship on small towns with a nursing or convelescent home within
its jurisdiction.
