SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to H.P. 2171, L.D. 2295, RESOLUTION,
Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution to Increase the Bonding
Limit on Maine Veterans' Mortgage Loans from \$2,000,000 to \$4,000,000
and to Decrease the Bonding Limit of the Maine School Building
Authority from \$25,000,000 to \$10,000,000.

Amend said Resolution by striking out all of the title and
inserting in place thereof the following: 'RESOLUTION, Proposing
an Amendment to the Constitution to Decrease the Bonding Limit of
the Maine School Building Authority from \$25,000,000 to \$10,000,000.

Further amend said Resolution by striking out all of the 4th
and 5th paragraphs.


Further amend said Resolution by striking out all of the
question and inserting in place thereof the following:

"Shall the Constitution be amended as proposed by a resolution
of the Legislature to Decrease the Bonding Limit of the Maine
School Building Authority from \$25,000,000 to \$10,000,000?"

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to remove all reference to
Maine veterans' mortgage loans from the bill.
