HOUSE AMENDMENT "C" to H.P. 2223, L.D. 2311, Bill,
"AN ACT to Revise the Statutes Concerning Alcoholic Beverages."

Amend said Bill in section 4 by striking out all of
that part designated "\$55." and inserting in place thereof
the following:

'\$55. Salaries and expenses

Each member of the commission shall receive a per diem
salary of \$50 and his actual expenses for the first 50 meetings
of each calendar year. For any meetings after the 50th meeting,
each member of the commission shall receive his actual expenses.'

Statement of Fact

The present statutes permit the State Liquor Commission
to meet 50 times per year for payment purposes. The figure
"30" in the bill is a misprint.
