HOUSE AMENDMENT " D " to H.P. 2223, L.D. 2311, Bill,  
"AN ACT to Revise the Statutes Concerning Alcoholic Beverages."

Amend said Bill in section 4 in that part designated  
"§57." by striking out all of the first paragraph and inserting  
in place thereof the following:

'The Commissioner of Finance and Administration, with  
the advice and consent of the commission, shall appoint a  
Director of the Bureau of Alcoholic Beverages whose term of  
office shall be coterminous with the Governor and who shall be  
subject to removal for cause by the Governor, the commission  
and the commissioner. The salary of the director shall be  
fixed by the Governor.'

Statement of Fact

The intent of this amendment is to remove the Director of  
the Bureau of Alcoholic Beverages from the classified service  
and to create a term coterminous with that of the Governor  
for this position.
