HOUSE AMENDMENT "E" to H.P. 2223, L.D. 2311, Bill,
"AN ACT to Revise the Statutes Concerning Alcoholic Beverages."

Amend said Bill in section 2 in that part designated
"§4." by striking out all of the 4th paragraph and inserting
in place thereof the following:

'Liquor may be sold in any municipality on the day of
holding a general election or state-wide primary after the
polls of that municipality have closed.'
