HOUSE AMENDMENT "F" to H.P. 2223, L.D. 2311, Bill,
"AN ACT to Revise the Statutes Concerning Alcoholic Beverages."

Amend said Bill in section 9 by inserting after the
3rd sentence, a new sentence to read:

'Upon receipt of all applications for a special agency
store in a municipality, the State Liquor Commission shall
notify the municipal officers of that municipality of the
proposed location of each applicant at least 30 days
prior to the final selection of an applicant or applicants
by the State Liquor Commission.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment proposes to inform the municipalities
of all applications for special agency stores. Presently,
municipalities are not required by law to be notified about
special agency store location and a proposed site or sites
could have an adverse effect on a municipality.
