HOUSE AMENDMENT "I" to H.P. 2223, L.D. 2311, Bill, "AN  
ACT to Revise the Statutes Concerning Alcoholic Beverages."

Amend said Bill in section 25 in subsection 4 by striking  
out all of paragraph A and inserting in place thereof the  
following:

'A. Class VI license, malt liquor only.....\$100  
(1) Class VI-A license--optional license--  
For retail stores and retail service  
organizations without a stock of groceries worth  
\$1,000 in wholesale value.....\$200'

Statement of Fact

This amendment decreases by \$25 fees for full-year licenses  
for the sale of malt liquor to be consumed off the premises.
