HOUSE AMENDMENT "K" to H.P. 2223, L.D. 2311, Bill, "AN ACT to Revise the Statutes Concerning Alcoholic Beverages."

Amend said Bill in section 4 in that part designated "§58." in the 3rd line from the end (same in L.D.) by inserting after the underlined word "Administration" the underlined words 'and the State Liquor Commission'
