SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 2223, L.D. 2311, Bill, "AN ACT to Revise the Statutes Concerning Alcoholic Beverages."

Amend said Bill in section 2 by inserting at the end of the last sentence of the 2nd paragraph of that part designated "§ 4.", before the period, the following:

'or by the licensee or his employees after all customers have left the premises'

Statement of Fact

This amendment permits a licensee or his employees to consume liquor on the licensee's premises after sale hours if of all/the licensee's customers have left the premises.
