HOUSE AMENDMENT "A " to H.P. 2225, L.D. 2315, Bill,
"AN ACT to Strengthen Litter Laws and Improve Solid Waste
Management in this State."

Amend said Bill in section 14 by striking out all
of subsection 2 of that part designated "§1866."
and inserting in place thereof the following:

#'2. Distributor acceptance. A distributor shall not refuse
to accept from any dealer any empty, unbroken, reasonably clean
beverage container of the kind, size and brand sold by the
distributor or refuse to pay to the dealer the refund value of
a beverage container as established by section 1863.'

Further amend said Bill in section 14 by inserting at
the end of that part designated "§1866." the following:

'4. Deposit required. A deposit of not less than the
refund value established under section 1863 shall be paid
by the consumer, or other person, on each beverage container
sold to him by a dealer.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment clarifies the provisions of the bill
and provides that a deposit must be paid on all beverage
containers sold.
