to Revise and Clarify the Freedom of Access Law."

Amend said Bill ←————→ by inserting at the end of
that part designated "§404." the following new sentence:
'This section shall not apply to proceedings of the House of
Representatives or Senate which are authorized under Article
IV, Part Third, section 4 of the Constitution of Maine.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment exempts legislative proceedings which
are authorized under the Maine Constitution from ^{provisions concerning} recorded or
live broadcasts.
