HOUSE AMENDMENT "F" to H.P. 2226, L.D. 2316, Bill, "AN ACT  
to Revise and Clarify the Freedom of Access Law."

Amend said Bill in section 1 by striking out all of the  
first sentence of that part designated "§406." and inserting in  
place thereof the following:

'Public notice shall be given for all public proceedings as defined  
in section 402, if these proceedings are a meeting of a body or agency  
consisting of 3 or more persons and the body or agency will deal with  
the expenditure of public funds or taxation, or will adopt policy,  
at the meeting.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment makes it clear that public notice is to be  
given only for meetings of official bodies that consist of 3 or  
more persons. It does not require notice of meetings that merely  
deal with policy, but only those at which policy will be adopted.
