HOUSE AMENDMENT "H" to H.P. 2226, L.D. 2316, Bill, "AN ACT to Revise and Clarify the Freedom of Access Law."

Amend said Bill in that part designated "§402." by inserting at the end of subsection 3 the following:

'E. Records, working papers, interoffice and intraoffice memoranda used by or prepared for subcommittees of the University of Maine Board of Trustees, Board of Trustees of the Maine Maritime Academy, or faculty and administrative committees of both institutions.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment will exempt from the definition of "public records" certain records, working papers and memoranda used by or prepared for subcommittees of the Board of Trustees of the University of Maine and of the Maine Maritime Academy or used by or prepared for faculty and administrative committees of those institutions.
