SENATE AMENDMENT "A " to H.P. 2249, L.D. 2323, Bill,  
"AN ACT to Prohibit Public Utilities from Including Certain  
Political Advertising Material along with Customer Bills."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of subsection 1  
of that part designated "§106." and inserting in place  
thereof the following:

'1. Inserts in customer bills. No public utility shall  
include with any bill, for services or commodities furnished  
any customer or subscriber, any advertising or literature  
to promote or defeat any candidate for nomination or election  
to any public office, to promote or defeat the appointment  
of any person to any administrative or executive position in  
local, county, State or Federal Government or to promote,  
modify or defeat any change in local, state or federal  
legislation, rules or regulations.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment removes the prohibition on inserting  
in customer bills advertising or literature concerning  
referendum measures.
