HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to S.P. 773, L.D. 2326, Bill,
"AN ACT Repealing the Expungement Law and Providing for the
Control of Access to and Disclosure of Criminal History Record
Information."

Amend said Bill in section 3 in that part designated
"§603." by inserting at the end of subsection 1 before the
underlined punctuation ";" the following: 'excluding
acquittals by reason of mental disease or defect'

Statement of Fact

This amendment excludes from the limitation or dissemination
of criminal history record information contained in section 603
those records relating directly to a crime for which a person
has been acquitted by reason of mental disease or defect.
