HOUSE AMENDMENT"⁽¹⁾ to H.P. 2257, L.D. 2327, Bill, "AN ACT to Revise the Laws Relating to the Maine Traffic Court."

Amend said Bill in section 35 by striking out all of the first sentence of that part designated "§531-B." and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Every licensee, including persons to whom a temporary driver's license has been issued, and every person to whom an instruction permit has been issued shall have his operator's license or instruction permit in his immediate possession at all times when operating a motor vehicle and shall display hand over for inspection the same upon demand of a police officer.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment ensures that an officer is able to inspect a driver's license for authenticity.
