HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " to H.P. 2258, L.D. 2330, Bill, "AN ACT to Clarify and Strengthen the Statute Governing Current Use Taxation of Farmland."

Amend said Bill in section 2 in that part designated "\$1102." in subsection 4 by striking out all of paragraphs A and B and inserting in place thereof the following:

'A. \$1,000 for 10 acres; and

B. \$100 per acre for each acre over 10, with the total income required not to exceed \$2,000.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to clarify the Committee on Taxation's intent that the total gross income required to qualify for classification as farmland shall never exceed \$2,000.
