HOUSE AMENDMENT" A" to S.P. 777, L.D. ²³³⁴, Bill, "AN ACT to Revise the Maine Criminal Code as Recommended by the Criminal Law Revision Commission."

Amend said Bill by inserting after section 102 the following:

Sec. 103. 17-A MRSA \$1107, sub-\$17/as enacted by PL 1975, c. 499, \$1, are repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

A. Expressly authorized by Title 22;

B. Expressly made a civil violation by Title 22; or

C. Subject to section 1107-A.

Sec. 104. 17-A MRSA §1107-A is enacted to read:

§1107-A. Possession of usable amount of marijuana

Possession of a usable amount of marijuana is a Class E crime.'

Further amend said Bill by inserting after section 125 the following:

repealed and replaced 'Sec. 126. 22 MRSA §2383, as / by PL 1975, c. 499, §51 is repealed.'
