HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to S. P. 777, L.D. 2334, Bill, "AN ACT to Revise the Maine Criminal Code as Recommended by the Criminal Law Revision Commission."

Amend said Bill in section 26 by striking out all of subsection 4 of that part designated "§104."

in section 26  
Further amend said Bill/by renumbering subsection 5 of that part designated "§104." to be subsection 4.

Further amend said Bill in section 66 by striking out all of subsection 3 of that part designated "§506." and inserting in place thereof the following:

'3. Harassment by telephone is a Class E crime.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment eliminates the requirement that a person in possession or control of a dwelling house must give warning before using deadly force. It reduces the offense of harassment by telephone to a Class E crime in order to make the penalty for this crime the same as for simple harassment.
