SENATE AMENDMENT "A " to HOUSE AMENDMENT "E" to S.P. 777,  
L.D. 2334, Bill, "AN ACT to Revise the Maine Criminal Code as  
Recommended by the Criminal Law Revision Commission."

Amend said Amendment by striking out all of the 6th  
paragraph.

Further amend said Amendment in the 8th paragraph in  
the 2nd line by inserting after the underlined word "citation"  
the following: 'for a violation of Title 22, section 2383'

Statement of Fact

The purposes of this amendment are to retain the authority  
to deliver citations for all civil violations and to make the  
failure to appear in court a Class E crime for all civil  
violations. The amendment retains the limitation on the officer's  
authority to require identification to suspected marijuana  
violations contained in the house amendment being amended.
