SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 2263, L.D. 2335, Bill, "AN ACT to Allow County Budget Determination at the County Level."

Amend said Bill in section 6 by inserting after the stricken out line of the last "budget" in the last paragraph the underlined words 'with the approval of the county finance board'

Further amend said Bill in section 7 by striking out all of the first sentence of the 3rd paragraph of that part designated "§1121." and inserting in place thereof the following: 'The members of the board shall be elected at the biennial meetings of voters for the election of Senators and Representatives as established by the Constitution of Maine, Article II, Section 4, for terms of 2 years in the same manner as are town officials, when such officials are nominated by nomination papers and elected by secret ballot.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment gives county commissioners of all counties the right to borrow in anticipation of taxes "with the approval of the county finance board." The amendment also sets the date for holding elections for the county finance board.
