SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 2269, L.D. 2336, RESOLVE, to Require the Department of Human Services to Reopen the Itinerant Office in Belfast.

Amend said Resolve by striking out all of the last paragraph before the emergency clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Resolved: That the department shall continue to maintain an operational office in the Belfast area unless the Legislature at a future date directs the department to close such an office; and be it further

Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Fund the sum of \$45,000 to carry out the purposes of this resolve; and that any of these funds unexpended at the end of the fiscal year shall not lapse but shall carry forward into subsequent fiscal years, to be expended for the purposes of this resolve.'

Statement of Fact

The primary purpose of this amendment is to provide that funds appropriated to maintain an office in Belfast shall not lapse at the end of the fiscal year.
