Amend said amendment by striking out all of the first 2 paragraphs and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:'

Further amend said amendment in the 3rd paragraph by striking out in the 3rd line the following words: "<u>Contract Review</u> <u>Committee</u>" and inserting in place thereof the following: 'Standardization Committee'

Further amend said amendment in the 4th paragraph by striking out in the first line the words "<u>Contract Review Committee</u>" and inserting in place thereof the following: 'Standardızation Committee'

Further amend said amendment by striking out in the 5th paragraph, 3rd line, the following: "<u>Contract Review Committee</u>" and inserting in place thereof the following: '<u>Standardization</u> Committee'

Further amend said amendment by striking out in the 2nd line of the 6th paragraph the following: "<u>Contract Review Committee</u>" and inserting in place thereof the following: '<u>Standardization</u> Committee' HOUSE AMENDMENT" "to HOUSE AMENDMENT"A"to HP 2278, LD 2339

Further amend said amendment by striking out in the first line of the 8th paragraph the following: "<u>Contract Review</u> <u>Committee</u>" and inserting in place thereof the following: 'Standardization Committee'

Further amend said amendment by inserting in both sentences of the 9th paragraph, after the underlined words "<u>rules</u> and regulations" the following: '<u>relating to purchasing</u>, bidding and contracts, other than consultant contracts, '

Further amend said / amendment out in the first sentence the following: "<u>Contract Review Committee</u>" and inserting in place thereof the following: '<u>Standardization</u> Committee'

Statement of Fact

This amendment retains the original name of the Standardization Committee in order to avoid possible confusion with a committee established by executive order which has a name similar to the name Contract Review Committee.

The amendment also more narrowly defines those regulations promulgated by the State Purchasing Agent which are subject to the review and approval of the Standardization Committee.
